Unfortunately, we won't be able to hold our usual 'moving up morning', where children are able to spend time with their new teacher. However, children in Years 4 and 5 will be able to meet Mrs Corby and Mr Munday as we have been able to agree times for them both to be in school and spend time in class. Mr Munday will be in school every day until the end of term and will spend time with his new class when they come into school for their planned sessions.

For (current) Year 3, Mrs Corby can only be released from her current school on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings, so for the last week of term, we are planning to change the Y3 visit sessions from the afternoons to the mornings; this means that Year 3 children should come to school for 9.15am on either Tuesday or Wednesday morning, finishing at 11.15. I realise this is a change to our original plans, but we feel it important that the children are able to meet their new teacher – thank you for your understanding and co-operation with this change.

There is still a lot of work to be done to get ready for September, but I am hopeful that we can manage a safe and sensible return to school in the Autumn term for everyone.
